<u>Supervision and Evaluation of Activities relating to Solid Waste Management at</u> Provincial Level

As per 8.4.1 (b) of the National Policy on Waste Management, our Ministry, as the line Ministry should provide facilities and guidance to local authorities and provincial councils for urban waste management in compliance with their Annual Action Plans. Furthermore, as per the said National Policy, the responsibility of supervision, evaluation and reporting on urban waste management also lies with the Ministry. As such, the National Solid Waste Management Support Centre, implements this with the objective of fulfilling all these requirements by prioritizing five objectives.

- 1. Checking on the success of waste management activities of local authorities in each province
- 2. Identifying the issues arisen in waste management activities in the province
- 3. Enforcement of presently approved national and international policies in all provinces
- 4. Dissemination of knowledge to all provinces on identified best practices
- 5. Providing training to officers engaged in solid waste management activities in local authorities

Accordingly, it has been planned to implement one workshop for each province so as to cover 341 local authorities in Sri Lanka and this workshop was presently held in two provinces. The details thereof appear below.
